In compliance with the Memorandum dated 27, March 2020 issued by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau Re Realignment of Social Development and Management Programs unutilized funds to support affected impact and non- impact communities due to COVID-19 and Memorandum from the Executive Secretary dated March 31, 2020 requiring the submission of the Report to Congress pursuant to RA No. 11469, the Mining Companies in CARAGA Region assist and support both the community residents and frontliners in partnership with the Local Government Unit (Barangay, Municipality, Province) against COVID 19 virus.

In response to the needs of the community, the companies provided goods and other means of support to at least help sustain the day to day needs of the community and the frontliners. A total of Php16,261,360.10 were utilized by the aforesaid mining companies with a budget allocation of PhP of 31,726,725.75, subject for implementation.

Issues Encountered

The mining companies has not encountered issues in delivering its assistance and services to the communities and frontliners.

However, some companies have some concerns like its future distributions that might be delayed as access to suppliers for additional food items are restricted due to lockdown. Delayed in the arrival in the PPEs as local supplies in the province are no longer available and items will have to be shipped out somewhere.

Also, there are scarcity of supplies of the vitamins and disinfectants and the transportation and mobilization of goods is also quite hard because of the different policies each area for the boundary pass.
